- **Ontario Scholar Certificate** issued by the Ontario Ministry of Education, **and**
- **Transcript(s)** from their final year of secondary school to be eligible; **and**,
- **Confirmation of enrollment** in the first year of post-secondary education program; **and**,
- **Confirmation or documentation** to support Czech or Slovak ancestral criteria:
  - (a) has completed two or more years of Czech or Slovak **language school** during the past 10 years; **or**,
  - (b) is able to **converse** in either Czech or Slovak languages; **or**,
  - (c) is a member or has parents that have **been members of Masaryk Memorial Institute** during the past 10 years; **or**
  - (d) is a member or has parents that have **been members of Sokol organization**; **or**
  - (e) alternative criteria such as participation in dance, theatre, church events that demonstrate involvement in the Czech or Slovak community will be considered;
- **A Student Profile:** tell us more about yourself, your extracurricular interests and involvement as well as your academic goals and aspirations. Maximum one page in length.
